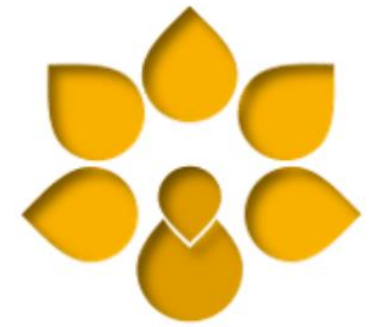

Spoleto, once the capital of the medieval duchy, is an artistically lively city surrounding by olive groves and vineyards.



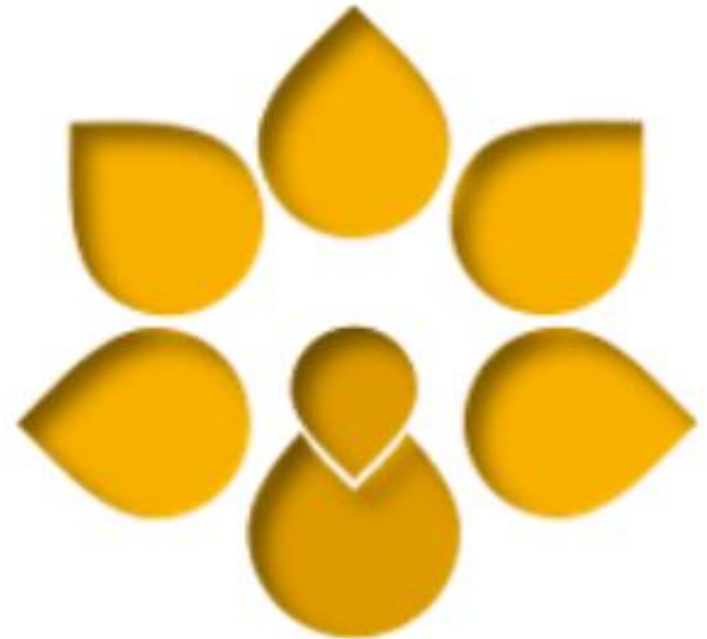

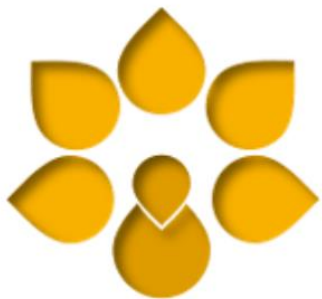

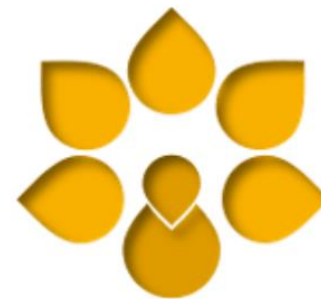
