Spend the day getting to know **Lucca**, a beautiful city in Tuscany known for its well-preserved Renaissance walls encircling its historic city center and its cobblestone streets. Lucca was the principal city in Tuscany in the 9th and 10th centuries, when its counts became the margraves of Tuscany, and it commanded one of the principal roads between Lombardy and Rome, the Via Francigena. The city began to lose importance in the late 10th century to Florence, which replaced Lucca as the Tuscan capital

The **aqueduct** comprised of over 400 arches is a monument in the countryside to local history that stretches from Lucca to the slopes of Mount Pisano where a small temple/cistern marks the point where the aqueduct runs underground until it reaches the springs that provide Lucca with its water. While passing ancient houses students will learn about the history of the region as the path gives way to forest and olive groves.
